

Flint recording – key points to remember

Where to go

- paths & tracks
- eroded areas
- stream gullies/drainage grips as required

What to look for

- flints loose on surface or *in situ* at path edges
- flints in exposed sections – look at bottom of peat and in pinkish mineral soil beneath

What to record on the bags

- General location and type of location
- Grid reference (as accurate as possible) and/or paced positional detail
- Number of pieces and material in which found
- Your name and the date

*Example Eroding path Glaisdale Moor
SE 7385 9967 30 paces NE of grouse butt
4 flints loose on mineral soil
M Waughman 27/03/08*

Remember!

- Don't dig for flints or remove them unless they are loose or threatened with imminent disturbance
- keep to paths/tracks in nesting season (April-July)
